

Cindy White was reappointed as Municipal Agent to the Elderly for the town of New Fairfield on March 3, 2026. The Municipal Agent for the Elderly program was established in 1972 by the Connecticut State Legislature to ensure that each of Connecticut's 169 towns and cities has an officially appointed town representative to assist individuals 60 and over in their community. Municipal agents provide information and referral services, distribute information, assist individuals in learning about community resources, and help with applying for benefits.

A Municipal Agent for the Elderly is a town-appointed professional who serves as a central resource for older adults and their families, helping them understand and access the programs, benefits, and services that support safe, independent living. They guide people through applications for Medicare, Medicaid, Social Security, energy assistance, and local tax relief; connect them with home-care services, transportation, meal programs, housing options, and caregiver support; and advocate on their behalf when issues arise.
