

THE CLOISTERS, a branch of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, is a remarkable place to visit. Situated in Upper Manhattan overlooking the Hudson River, the museum is devoted to the art, architecture, and gardens of medieval Europe. Visiting the Cloisters is like traveling through time to a building that evokes the Middle Ages. The Cloisters opened to the public in 1938 and was designed to resemble a French Romanesque abbey.

Our GUIDED TOUR will highlight the extraordinary medieval architecture, the famed Unicorn Tapestries, brilliant stained glass windows, illuminated manuscripts with time in the gardens.
