The Frick Collection - a premier art museum on the Upper East Side - has reopened after completing an expansive renovation project of this 1914 mansion, which houses art from the Renaissance to the early twentieth century. Founded by Henry Clay Frick, the museum offers visitors intimate encounters with one of the world's foremost collections of European fine and decorative arts. The collection includes celebrated works by Rembrandt, Fragonard, Ingres, Bellini, Vermeer, and more.
